





Enrolment of Students with limited English skills

The following areas are agreed upon by the school and parents in order to support

| a new student to ISoB, with limited English skills. |
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| 1. The school will provide extra ESL support lessons, the number of which to be determined on the individual needs of the student. |
| 2. The school will provide a support teacher in the classroom as needed. |
| 3. The school will implement integration lessons, to encourage the child's classroom integration, as well as between classes to lessen initial stresses. |
| 4. The school will seek the help of the psychologist if needed, or may suggest outside psychological support in severe cases, in order to minimize behavioural issues that may arise. |
| 5. The school will monitor the progress of the child's English and the support level will be adjusted according to their needs, but support will be provided by the school for a minimum of 3 months. |
| 6. The parents agree to allow their child to watch cartoons or films appropriate for their age, in English, at least 3 times a week. |
| 7. The parents agree to read in English with their child, on a daily basis. The child needs to also read aloud to the parents. The level of books will be discussed with the head of the ESL department. |
| 8. The parents undertake to support the child in their homework tasks. |
| 9. In the case of parents without English, the parents undertake to provide extra-curricular support in the form of lessons after school hours. In this case, the school requires written evidence of the child's enrolment in lessons outside of school. |
| 10. Both parties agree to meet at the end of to discuss progress and if further support is required. |
